Contest rules :

1. Contest is open to all interested parties in the public. Participants are permitted to sign up for one or more of the competition groups.
2. Entry fee is non-refundable and must accompany entry form.
3. The organizer reserves the right to disqualify anyone not following procedures or contest rules, or for being disruptive or disrespectful to any person or property.
4. All contestants must check-in at least 15 minutes prior to the contest time.
5. Contestants who do not show up without reasonable excuse will be automatically disqualified.
6. The organizer reserves the right to cancel any or all of the contest groups if there are not enough participants to compete in any or all of the contest groups. Upon cancellation, entry fee will be refunded to participants accordingly.

Contest details:

There are three groups in the contest: Individual, Corporation, and Family. There are no limitations for number of entries with each contestant. However, certain age requirements are applied for each contest in the Individual group. Champions from each group are eligible to compete in the Final Contest.

Individual : Group 1 – ages 10 to 17 (male or female)
Group 2 – ages 18 to 40 (male or female)
Group 3 – ages 41 or above (male or female)
Contest – contestant to finish as much food provided as they can within 1 minute.

Corporation : Each Corporation team consists of 4 representatives
Contest: To start, the team has the option of choosing chopsticks, forks or by hands to feed the food. The first team member will feed one piece of snack into the mouth of the second team member. The second team member will feed the third team member, the third to the fourth team member and so on. When the round is complete, cycle back to the first team member. The game is won by the team which scores the highest points within a minute of time.
(Extra 10 points for using chopsticks, 5 points for using fork, and no extra points

for hands)

Family : 3 members of a family form one team, one of the team members must be under the age of 12.

Contest: Two of the team members will be blindfolded: one is responsible for eating the food and the other is responsible for feeding the food. From a distance, the third team member verbally directs the feeding member to deliver the snack to the mouth of the team member being fed. The first team that delivers the snack to the appropriate team member's mouth will be the winner of the contest.

Final Contest : Champions from all of the above contests are eligible.

Contest –All eligible participants from Individual and Corporation groups are divided into groups of 2 members each, together with the champions of Family group to compete with each other. Each group will stack up as much given snacks as possible within a minute.

Declaration:

1. The contestant confirms that all information given on the application form is true and correct. If any of the information given by the Contestant is false or incorrect, the Organizer reserves the right to disqualify the Contestant without any liability to the Organizer.
2. The Contestant understands and agrees that the Organizer has the absolute right at any time to:
 - a. Refuse entry to those being disruptive or disrespectful to any person or property, or those that do not follow contest rules and regulations, with a full refund;
 - b. Disqualify any Contestant from contesting, who is being disruptive or disrespectful to any person or property, or does not follow contest rules and regulations, with a full refund;
 - c. Amend or cancel the date and venue;
 - d. Amend the food provided for contests.
3. The Contestant understands and agrees that:
 - a. he/she is aware of the risk inherent to health in the consumption of the food provided for the contest. The health risk may be of food allergy, high food calories, food-choking and other related risks over the duration of the contest. By signing this Entry Form, the contestant (s) relieves the responsibility of the

Organizer of any loss or allergic reactions, including but not limited to personal injuries or fatality that may occur during and after the contest.

- b. the decisions of the Organizer and those of the judges are final and absolute;
- c. the Organizer shall have the absolute right to arrange video and audio recording production, newspaper promotion and any other means of media publicity of the winners, in the venue during and after the contest;
- d. the Organizer has the right to waive or modify the above information in relation to individual Contestant with regard to the information provided by the Contestant.
